- 3. Supervising and providing feedback on the implementation of the maintenance programmes, with the objective of prolonging the useful life of the Company's Electrical Works and ensuring performance to industry standards.
- 4. Assisting in forecasting departmental operating costs and monitoring departmental performance in the area of Electrical Maintenance.
- 5. Assisting with the acquisition of equipment, materials and services in accordance with the planned annual programme and budget.
